* If students are fluent in a language that is not among those offered by the AP Program, they may still qualify for APID. They may submit a letter from an administrator verifying the student's mastery of a language. This verification, printed on school letterhead, will satisfy the requirement for ONE AP Exam in the language category. However, a student who utilizes this option must submit an additional AP Exam from another content area. (**Category 4 above) Thus, all students, however they satisfy the two-exam English and foreign language requirement, must submit a total of five AP Exam grades of 3 or higher to qualify for the APID.
